<b>Task/Substance Description</b>  Bactdet D 05 Clear aqueous liquid consisting of 2-Phenylphenol Benzalkonium chloride plus detergent.	<b>Location/Department/Area</b>  N/A
<b>Task Location</b>  Various location, primarily internal rooms in residential buildings.	
<b>Substances/Processes in Use</b>  Dilute material 1 part to 4 parts clean warm/cold water First part of treatment used for killing mould. Infected mould area is washed with solution, applied using sponge, cloth or brush.	<b>Record Number</b>  (Empty)
<b>Frequency and Duration of Exposure</b>  Dependent on size of infected area, generally short duration for application. Repeat application may be necessary after wall paper is removed.	
<b>Control Measures in Use</b>  Ensure sufficient ventilation to the area Impermeable protective clothing Tightly fitting safety goggles Disposable P2 Respirator Impermeable Gloves Ensure eye bath is to hand	
<b>Risk rating (High, medium, low)</b>  LOW  Irritant. Harmful if swallowed and irritating to skin and eyes. Signal Word. Warning
